Advocacy Committee Report, by Michael Unsworth

The March 8 meeting was canceled due to high winds.

Government Activities and Projects:

- Steve Leiby, Tim Potter, and Mike Unsworth participated in two meetings that are drafting the Tri-County Regional Planning Commission's Non-Motorized Transportation (NMT) Plan
- Ingham County Trails Millage:

Steve Leiby, Dean Brailey, and Lenny Provencher attended various meetings with the millage Ingham County established a Special Trails and Parks Committee to review the current procedure of awarding funding to communities

- Steve Leiby, Tim Potter, and Mike Unsworth attended the Michigan Dept. of Transportation's University Region NMT meeting
- Ingham County on March 28 established a Special Complete Streets Committee which will assess the feasibility of a complete streets plan and policy for county roads
- At the April Advocacy meeting:
 - Anne Readett of the Michigan State Police's Office of Highway Safety Planning explained the new federal program that will provide funding for safety projects devoted to Non-motorized Safety
 - Scott House (East Lansing's Director of Public Works) discussed recent and future road projects that will impact bicyclists and pedestrians.

Speakers' Bureau: Presentations on "Bicycles: Frequently Asked Questions" have been given to the Bath Lions and St. Johns Rotary clubs. The Dewitt Sunrise Rotary has been booked

for May 11

Local Safe Passing Ordinances: East Lansing is the first community to be approached. Mike Unsworth has sent a draft of model legislation and will make a presentation to the East Lansing City Council on May 16.

Ride of Silence: Planning is progressing for the May 17 event

Reminders of a need for state-wide vulnerable road user legislation

- On March 30, the Lansing State Journal reported that Mitzi Nelson was arrested on January 1 for driving while impaired and having open intoxicants in a motor vehicle. Nelson struck and killed 35-year- old Jill Byelich in September 2014. In 2015, she received several months of jail time, two years of parole, and other restrictions. Her new arrest is a violation of her parole.
- Cyclists' Lives Count Protest Ride: On April 13 Tim Potter & Lenny Provencher joined over 170 cyclists who rode from Dexter to Chelsea for the sentencing of driver Terry LaCroix who killed triathlete Karen McKeachie last year. LaCroix' sentence was two years of probation, \$3,000 in fines and 240 hours in community service. He will do no jail time.


